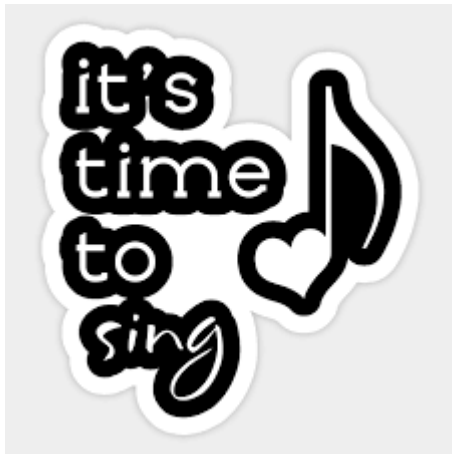

Relief

History records food shortages from AD 45–47, during the reign of Emperor Claudius, who began reigning in AD 41. Sometime before the famine, one of the prophets of the church (Agabus) demonstrated by the Holy Spirit that a famine would afflict the whole world. Luke, writing in hindsight, makes a record of this fact for no other reason than to demonstrate the communal way the church looked out for sister congregations (Acts 11:27–30). Jerusalem wasn't that far from Antioch, so prophets made the journey.

On the other side of the world, our brethren have suffered in Ukraine due to an invasion. Thankfully, we have the mediums of communication we have and the ability to be apprised of the developing situation. For years, this congregation has supported Harvey Starling's work in Romania through the Midway Church of Christ in Jasper, Alabama. This congregation's generosity has so touched me. Whenever you've known of a need, you've always stepped up.

You all have contributed a little over \$50,000 to be disbursed to the Romanian congregations. These sister churches are aiding Ukrainian refugees as they are able. Because of your benevolence and love for the Lord and his people, you have made the load a little easier for our brothers and sisters. Though the circumstances aren't favorable, it may be that the Lord works through them to lead others to faith in him. We can only pray for such an increase.

In addition to the monetary gifts you've given, you also donated enough supplies that our C20 group filled 103 five-gallon buckets that will be handed off to Healing Hands International. They will see that these buckets of supplies make it to Ukraine to help those still in the country. Perhaps you couldn't donate either money or supplies. Maybe you couldn't even help stuff the buckets. However, you've significantly contributed to the relief if you have prayed. There's no telling how God has answered those prayers. Whether you contributed physically or spiritually, you have contributed. Thank God for you and the hearts he has given us all in Christ.
