Jesus' Promise to Build His Church

The Power of Surrender
Surrendering control to God is not reakness but a path to strength. Siblical examples (Jehoshaphat, the ridow, Moses, Job, Peter, Paul & ilas, Lazarus) illustrate the power of

"Church" is, I believe, an inaccurate translation of *ekklesia*. It came to us through various languages, which ultimately derived from *kyriakos* ("the Lord's). This seems to have been used since AD 300 and onward, and when we think of the "church," we ultimately envision the building wherein we meet. "Church" refers to the building where we meet, and sometimes well-meaning Christians admonish us to "be the church and not simply go to church." However, to describe our meeting places as churches—the word itself having derived from the German *Kirche*—is not altogether wrong.

Ekklesia is often broken down by its compounds to define it in older scholarly works and many modern tomes: ek meaning "out of" and kaleo meaning "call." Hence, the church is often described as the "called out," but out of what are we called? The world, so we're told. Jesus promised to build (architectural language) His "church" or "assembly." How should we understand this? "Assembly" refers to what was done and not where. It was often used to describe the citizens of a Greek city who gathered and made decisions for the city-state. The word is used in this vein in Acts 7:38 and 19:32, 40. To the Greeks, it was a noble word and denoted the activities of Greek civic life. The way that Matthew likely intended to portray it was in continuation of Israel's history. Ekklesia and sometimes synagoge replace the Hebrew term in the Greek Old Testament that denoted the gathered people of God. A Jewish reading of the term would conclude that it must be understood as "assembly" as such, appearing at the base of Mt. Sinai when all Israel was assembled before God (cf. Deut. 4:9-10; 9:10-11; 18:15-16 LXX). However, feel free to use it as you see fit.

Let me encourage you to trust, wait, and receive blessings through prayer. Trust in God releases burdens we cannot carry. Letting go is not weakness; it creates space for divine intervention.

Trust is demonstrated through action, not just feeling. Proverbs 3:5-6 emphasizes relying on God for direction, not personal understanding. Surrender enables God's power to work beyond our personal strength.

Proverbs 3:5-6

5 Trust in the Lord with all your heart, And lean not on your own understanding; 6 In all your ways acknowledge Him, And He shall direct your paths.

I pray that each of us will surrender to the direction that God leads today and have faith in His guidance.

Library E. Bailev Factoid # 1

As congregations go, Glendale is a relative newcomer, having been reorganized in 1909. While not technically within the boundaries of Calloway, the oldest continuously operating Church of Christ in Calloway or Henry Counties is Blood River, which was organized in 1842. The oldest congregation just to our west over in Graves County would be Antioch which has been at its current location just across the county line since 1853 but was organized back in the 1830s in Calloway before being moved to what is now Antioch church Road.

In terms of the currently existing congregations in presentday Calloway, that predate Glendale, the following are in chronological order:

New Concord before 1845, Green Plain 1854, Friendship c1876, Pleasant Valley 1886, New Providence 1889, Union Grove 1890, Mt. Olive 1896, Hazel c1900, Williams Chapel 1905. (several others have been added since this time)
