beatitudes.

Blessed *are* the meek, For they shall inherit the earth.

Meekness (praótes) in the NT is a natural virtue, a Christian grace, and one of the "fruits of the spirit" (Gal 5:23). Jesus said, "Take my yoke upon you, and learn from me; for I am gentle (meek) and lowly in heart" (Matt 11:29). Paul said, "I...entreat you, by the meekness and gentleness of Christ—I who am humble" (2 Cor 10:1). Paul not only extolled and emulated this virtue of Christ but commended it to his churches. "I therefore, a prisoner for the Lord, beg you to lead a life worthy of the calling to which you have been called, with all lowliness and meekness..." (Eph 4:1f.). He admonished the Colossians to put on the graces of "compassion, kindness, lowliness, meekness, and patience..." (Col 3:12). Likewise he commends it to Timothy and to Titus (1 Tim 6:11; Titus 3:2). James instructs Christians to "receive with meekness the implanted word" (Jas 1:21); and recommends to the wise and understanding that "By his good life let him show his works in the meekness of wisdom" (3:13). Peter wrote that all Christians should always be prepared to make a defense of their hope "with gentleness and reverence" (1 Pet 3:15).

## **Resurrection of the Dead**

Continuing Hebrews 6:2 to discuss elementary principles Christians should know, we arrive at the next elementary principle. Scripture has a lot to say about the resurrection.

And many of those who sleep in the dust of the earth shall awake, some to everlasting life, some to shame and everlasting contempt. (Daniel 12:2)

Do not marvel at this; for the hour is coming in which all who are in the graves will hear His voice and come forth—those who have done good, to the resurrection of life, and those who have done evil, to the resurrection of condemnation. (John 5:28–29)

I have hope in God ... that there will be a resurrection of the dead, both of the just and the unjust. (Acts 24:15)

These passages present the truth that all dead will be raised, but those raised who are condemned will receive their condemnation while Christians will receive life, and not condemnation.

My favorite look at the resurrection is what Paul wrote about in 1 Corinthians 15:35–55. He contrasts our present state with what we will become at the resurrection.

- Corruption vs. Incorruption (v. 42)
- Dishonor vs. Glory (v. 43)
- Weakness vs. Power (v. 43)
- Natural vs. Spiritual (v. 44)
- Living vs. Life-giving (v. 45)
- Earthly vs. Heavenly (vv. 47–48)
- Mortal vs. Immortal (v. 54)

With the rise of liberal theology in the last half of the 20th century, this hymn became the center of fierce controversies within several denominations when it came time to revise their hymnbooks. As incredible as it appears to most of us, the argument of the left was that the hymn glorifies militarism.
