## **Resurrection**

Let's confess one thing out of the gate—belief in Jesus' resurrection is critical to Christianity. Yet, none of us have ever witnessed one in the miraculous sense of Jesus' resurrection. Some might chuckle at our belief, but it is not as farfetched as one might think. Let's start with a basic conclusion—a man named Jesus existed in first-century Judea. No historian disputes that he actually existed. They may not claim he was who we believe him to be, but the consensus is that he lived.

The next thing we know for sure from Scriptural and other historical sources was that he was crucified and died. We also know that the tomb was empty on the first day of the week (Sunday) after he was crucified. Even those hostile to Christ had concocted an excuse to explain the empty tomb (Matt. 28:11–15). Still, they stipulated that the tomb was, in fact, empty. Hopefully, everyone can agree on this point. Moving on, the risen Jesus was seen by over 500 people (1 Cor. 15:3–8). There's even eyewitness testimony to this fact (2 Peter 1:16; 1 John 1:1–3).

Is it scientific to believe in the resurrection? I believe so. Someone might say it isn't because it must be observed to be believed. Yet, the same people may have no problem believing that a Big Bang created everything. Plus, the wind is unseen, yet its effects are beheld. Science cannot prove beauty, but we all know it exists. I've never observed order arising from chaos or life deriving from non-life. However, nature shows signs of resurrection. Here we are in Spring, and what do we see? The vegetation that died in the fall and winter is coming back to life, thus demonstrating not only resurrection but the grandeur of God. Even the caterpillar enters a tomb to resurrect as a butterfly. Death and resurrection are seen in nature, so making the connection isn't a giant leap.

While not everyone will be persuaded, we Christians should be, at the very least.

Now if Christ is preached that He has been raised from the dead, how do some among you say that there is no resurrection of the dead? (1 Cor. 15:12)

### HYMNBOOKS # 8

The other individual who likely exerted the most influence on congregational singing in the Churches of Christ in the 20<sup>th</sup> century was Lloyd Otis Sanderson (1901-1992). A man of varied talents and careers, Sanderson is said to have written over 500 songs, a few of which have survived into our 21<sup>st</sup> century hymnbooks.

Sanderson is best remembered as having compiled and edited all three editions of the CHRISTIAN HYMNS series which the Gospel Advocate Company published in 1935, 1948 and 1966. The 1935 book was titled ***Christian Hymns for Every Purpose In Worship*** and Sanderson was assisted by four other well-known individuals, including Charles M. Pullias and N.B. Hardeman.

The 1935 book was a full-length hardback hymnal of some 400 numbers. L. O. Sanderson was killed while crossing the street too go to church in Memphis.
