## Conspiracy

**Peter's Denial:** Peter had promised to fight and even die for Jesus, but Jesus told him he would deny him three times before the rooster crows. William Barclay offers some insight into this:

It may well be that the cock-crow was not the voice of a bird; and that from the beginning it was not meant to mean that. After all, the house of the High Priest was right in the center of Jerusalem. And there was not likely to be poultry in the center of the city. There was, in fact, a regulation in the Jewish law that it was illegal to keep cocks and hens in the Holy City because they defiled holy things. But the hour of 3 a.m. was called *cock-crow*, and for this reason. At that hour the Roman guard was changed in the Castle of Antonia; and the sign of the changing of the guard was a *trumpet call*. The Latin for that trumpet call was *gallicinium*, which means *cock-crow*. It is at least possible that just as Peter made his third denial the trumpet from the castle battlements rang out over the sleeping city ... and Peter remembered; and thereupon he went and wept his heart out.

**The Chief Priest and Elders Move to Put Jesus to Death:** Now before a body of seventy of Jerusalem's elite religious leaders, The night trials have been illegal, so to give some measure of legitimacy to this whole charade, Jesus is taken to the Sanhedrin at daylight. Various names were assigned to the one God would send. They ask if he is the Messiah (Luke 22:67). Jesus refers to himself as the Son of God (Luke 22:69). This statement, along with all that he says, is Jesus essentially saying that he would one day sit in judgment over them as they presume to do to him at the moment.

**Judas Hang Himself (Matthew 27:3-10; Acts 1:18-19):** Jewish sources often point to analogous punishments. Since Jesus was to be hung on the cross, Judas hanged himself. In Acts, Herod and Ananias suffer horrible deaths, so the point is, "Don't oppose the kingdom of God." Matthew's account links Judas' betrayal to a fulfillment of Scripture, and Luke adds a detail of bursting. One plausible way to reconcile the two is that Judas' body may have swelled in Acts due to the heat. Also, the brand from which he hung himself may have given, causing his body to fall. "Headlong" can be misleading because we might think that he fell on the top of his head. The term here can mean forward, prone, or with the face downwards.

## **The Church's 2<sup>nd</sup> Most Important Book # 15**

Even though E. L. Jorgenson, with his long series of editions of *Great Songs of the Church* from the first release in 1921 to the final edition in 1986, is, arguably, the single greatest influence on the singing of Churches of Christ in the 20<sup>th</sup> century, his life and work were not without controversy.

Jorgenson became somewhat associated with the Premillennial element in the Churches of Christ beginning early in the century. After moving to Louisville, he edited the premillennial journal, *Word & Work*, which survives to this day. He also preached for many years for the Portland Avenue church and directed much of the activities of the Portland Christian schools, also in Louisville.

He was a close friend and associate of a man named Robert Henry Boll (1875-1956) who was a proponent of premillennial theology. (Boll is NOT to be confused with H. Leo Boles (1874-1946), a leading preacher, writer, editor & scholar in the Churches of Christ during his day.
