Who Am I?

Most of us feel inadequate and unqualified to point out another person's sin and draw a line in the sand. The people who feel qualified make us question their motives and character because, after all, only the self-righteous Pharisee is comfortable doing that. Right? Meanwhile, the rest of us struggle with our temptations and some with sins. So why should we point out another person's sins?

There's a difference between being a struggling sinner and an embracing sinner. We who struggle with our sins may feel remorse. We often also pray for forgiveness and try to do better. Whether or not we succeed is another matter. For others, they don't struggle with sin. They simply embrace it and make it a part of who they are. This is the difference between the Christian who has strayed and the one who has not. We don't have to draw a line in the sand because God has done that for us. However, one might wonder when to take action if that line is somewhat obscure.

For example, what does it mean to "wander from the truth," be "overtaken in any trespass," or to walk "disorderly?" Furthermore, the sins Paul mentioned to the Corinthians are generic. We can define them however we'd like, either broadly or narrowly. I've seen brethren use it in ways I'm not sure the Holy Spirit intended. "Wander from the truth" means different things to different people, but what did James mean? Walking disorderly is the same, so I have many questions about this process. We should care for our brethren, the good and the bad. We should encourage them all, but those who have wandered and been overtaken should be loved back to God.

This specific query is focused on knowing when to take restorative actions. If something alienates a person from God, then we should act. On the other hand, if it's a matter of personal scruples (Rom. 14-15:1), we should learn to bear with those and not make them points of faith, which many in the churches of Christ tend to do. Unfortunately, some people make things a matter of faith that are scruples.

How do we proceed from here? First, we should heed Jesus's warning (Matt. 7:1-5). Next, we deal with ourselves as a starting point and then determine the judgment we're using. Is it from God or man? Is it Scripture-based or tradition-based? Is a soul in peril, or do they just have a different point of view from me? Finally, we should carry out this task according to Paul's instructions: "Yet do not count him as an enemy, but admonish him as a brother" (2 Thess. 3:15).

Library E. Bailey HYMNBOOKS # 10

L. O. Sanderson's name won't mean much to folks here in the 21st century but he was a driving force in the singing of Churches of Christ in the last century.

The 1935 edition of his *Christian Hymns* contained 400 numbers drawn not only from our own tradition but from the wider world of hymnody as well.

The 1948 edition, which was the most successful of the three, contained 452 numbers, the bulk of which were simply lifted from the previous edition.

In 1966, the Gospel Advocate Company asked Sanderson to compile a third edition and *Christian Hymns 3* appeared with 502 numbers. Unfortunately, this edition was not a particular success due to the appearance of several new and competing hymnals during that time period.

To my knowledge, this was their final effort to market a hardback hymnal.
