## A Recent Conversation (Part 2)

“Let’s say I ask for the keys to your car. I will take it and have it serviced, filled up with gas, and detailed. I’ll return it when I’m done. What did you do to deserve any of that?” I asked my friend this, and he replied, “Nothing.” I told him that’s what grace is—me loving my friend so much that I want to do something for him. First, however, he must give me the keys. If he doesn’t, I can’t do anything with it.

This is how salvation works. God gifts us something we haven’t earned, nor can we. Yet, there will be no result if we don’t hand him the keys. So, as my pal and I continued speaking about baptism, I tried to clarify that we do not believe baptism is a work whereby we have “earned” salvation. We can’t earn it because it’s a gift. However, God works through baptism and our faith: “Buried with him in baptism, in which you also were raised with him through faith in the working of God” (Col. 2:12).

My friend has long had a hang-up because many people don’t teach baptism this way. Instead, they place all their faith in baptism while seemingly little in Jesus. We’re never told to believe in baptism but have faith in Jesus. We are immersed because of that faith, and we believe what God has said because of his faithfulness. When God says that he will wash away our sins (Acts 2:38; 22:16), save us (Mark 16:16) and that we are united with Christ in His death, burial, and resurrection through this medium (Rom. 6:3–6), we believe it. That’s why we do it. When Scripture says that the Holy Spirit adds us to the body of Christ when we’re baptized (1 Cor. 12:13), we believe it. Believing it and proclaiming it does not make it a work. It means we trust God’s promises attached to baptism.

Now, I would also like to mention how I explained that baptism alone accomplishes nothing. It must be accompanied by faith in Christ as God’s only son, confession of our belief, and repentance from sins. Every one of these is good, but no one alone is sufficient. Sometimes the way we have spoken about things, so I’ve learned, has misled others about what we believe. All we can do is have a civil conversation to clear the air, and I hope I was able to do that for my friend.

## 72 Years Ago!

In May of 1950, the Water Street Church relocated from 6<sup>th</sup> & Maple Streets over to the corner of 7<sup>th</sup> & Poplar Streets. A headline in the *Murray L&T* said "New Church of Christ To Open Tomorrow."

The article indicated that the building & contents were valued at approximately \$100,000 which translates to roughly \$1,192,962 in today's money and \$100,000 was a staggering sum to the relatively small congregation at that point in time.

As the church had no bulletin at that time and virtually no records were kept, we don't know any specifics as to attendance or offering that Sunday but the very first printed church directory which came out in 1952, would indicate that the relocation jumpstarted a rapid period of growth. There would still be a few members who were there on that May Sunday in 1950.
