Instructions at Passover

Moving to John 14, Jesus comforts his disciples. The popular translation of “mansions” has withstood the test of time, but “rooms” is more accurate. At this time, it was customary for a son to add to their father’s house once married so that the entire estate became a compound centered around a courtyard. This language envisions a Greco-Roman villa with many terraces and buildings in a garden with abundant trees and flowing water. The nearby Herodian palace would have been in mind as this was discussed. Jesus’ preparation of a home is reminiscent of God’s preparation for Israel’s entry into the Promised Land (Deut. 1:29–33). Thomas’ confusion leads to Jesus’ explanation, which combines “way” and “truth,” a combination attested in Psalm 86:11. His answers only lead to further uncovering of their ignorance.

Jesus alludes to the Holy Spirit (14:16–17, 26). In the first passage, our translations render him as “helper,” but “advocate” is more faithful to *parakletos*. A paraclete was a legal assistant, pleader, advocate, or one who pleads for another’s cause. When read in this light, we see the Spirit advocating for them by giving them complete remembrance of Jesus’ teachings when we arrive at verse twenty-six. Also, through them he will testify of Jesus (15:26–27), work wonders to convince the world of the gospel (16:8–9) and teach them all things (16:13).

The word “peace” often denoted the absence of war, but in Hebrew thought, the term *shalom* carried the notion of joyous blessing and of a right relationship with God. The prophets looked forward to the messianic era of peace, which they likely understood as the absence of war when it had more to do with peace with God (Is. 9:6; 52:7, Ezek. 37:26; Zech 9:10). Jesus expressly says that his peace is unlike that given by the world (14:27).
