## "But They Didn't Have the New Testament"

We primarily follow the New Testament to be Christians and the church. Yet, someone once asked how they did it since they didn't have the New Testament. Jesus died and rose somewhere between AD 27-33. The New Testament was written until the end of the first century. Yet, the New Testament wasn't all put together as we have it until the fourth century. How did they do things without the New Testament, as we have it? After all, the collection of these books steers the church of Christ today. There are several answers to this question. They entrusted sound doctrine to others (2 Tim. 2:2). They already recognized certain writings as Scripture (2 Peter 3:15–16). Paul quoted Luke 10:7 in 1 Timothy 5:18. Unanimity was taught so that what was taught in one church was taught in all (1 Cor 4:17; 7:17; 16:1). New Testament writings were circulated (Col. 4:16; 1 Thess. 5:27; 1 Peter 1:1; Rev. 1:4).

When we look beyond Scriptural evidence, the picture becomes clearer. Didache (AD 50–60) refers to the Lord's Prayer as it appears in Matthew. The letter 1 Clement was written near AD 95, and he alludes to the writings of Paul as Scripture and Matthew, Luke, Acts, James, and 1 Peter. In AD 110, Ignatius alludes to Matthew, Luke, and John. Polycarp in AD 110 calls Ephesians Scripture. He also references Romans, 1 Corinthians, Galatians, Philippians, 2 Thessalonians, and 1 & 2 Timothy; he quotes Matthew, Mark, and Luke. Then, there's the secondcentury description of a worship meeting.

"And on the day called Sunday, all who live in cities or in the country gather together to one place, and the memoirs of the apostles or the writings of the prophets are read...the president verbally instructs, and exhorts to the imitation of these good things. Then we all rise together and pray, and, as we before said, when our prayer is ended, bread and wine and water are brought, and the president in like manner offers prayers and thanksgivings, according to his ability, and the people assent, saying Amen; and there is a distribution to each, and a participation of that over which thanks have been given, and to those who are absent a portion is sent by the deacons. And they who are well to do, and willing, give what each thinks fit; and what is collected is deposited with the president, who succours the orphans and widows and those who, through sickness or any other cause, are in want, and those who are in bonds and the strangers sojourning among us, and in a word takes care of all who are in need. But Sunday is the day on which we all hold our common assembly" (Justin Martyr, First Apology 67; AD 155–157).

# Library E. Bailey HYMNBOOKS # 1

Printed hymnbooks as we know them are relatively recent in common use. Hymnbooks were expensive to produce and were carefully handled throughout the  $17^{\text{th}}$  &  $18^{\text{th}}$  centuries and well into the  $19^{\text{th}}$  century. Wealthy individuals would often buy their own personal leather-bound copies which they took home with them after each service. Some churches were wealthy enough to buy multiple copies but these were often kept in a secure place between services.

Songbooks of this period were usually words only without musical notation which gradually became more common as the 19<sup>th</sup> century dragged on. In 1855, The *Plymouth Collection* was issued by Henry Ward Beecher's Plymouth Church in Brooklyn, New York and this hymnal set the standard for many years to come with 1300 hymns and 367 tunes (many well-known tunes were sung to several different hymns.
