## The Church

People will often ask, “What church do you go to,” or “What denomination are you?” Really what they mean is, “What does the sign say?” Church signage is intended to identify a group of people, but it’s also meant to identify their beliefs. Many designations do not seem inviting to people but to repel them since they have heard X, Y, or Z about specific names. When I told someone that I preached for the church of Christ, she replied, “Oh, y’all are the ones who think you’re the only ones going to heaven?” Another replied, “Y’all don’t believe in music, do you?” Of all the things to be known by, I’d rather someone know us by our love for one another. This, after all, is how Jesus said we would be known as his disciples—by our love (John 13:35).

In the late 1700s, several people from various traditions—primarily Methodists, Baptists, and Presbyterians—grew weary of divisions within their tradition. One man who was tired of this was Rice Haggard—a Republican Methodist (not to be confused with a political party since it wasn’t officially formed until Lincoln). At a meeting of the Springfield Presbytery, overseen by Barton Stone, Haggard proposed that they should go by the name “Christian,” citing Acts 11:26. He further added that the scriptures were sufficient to govern the church of Christ, and any other written laws or rules were calculated to separate and divide. From this point onward, those wanting Christian unity went solely by this biblical name, shedding their sectarian names and many even appealed to their denomination for the same. They didn’t want to create something new but recapture what Christ had established.

While the New Testament doesn’t command any specific name be on the sign, the church is referred to in many ways—Body of Christ (Eph. 1:22–23; Col. 1:24), Bride of Christ (Rev. 21:9), the church of God (Acts 20:28); the church of the living God (1 Tim. 3:15), the church of the first-born (Heb. 12:23), Israel of God (Gal. 6:16), and church of Christ (Rom. 16:16) among others. Sadly, the noble name we call ourselves as an assembly is viewed as just another among many. Some of this can be credited to the multiple divisions among ourselves—some necessary and others not. Yet, we go by a name found in Scripture regardless.

While we can’t control what other people think, we can contribute to the good of the body of Christ by showing the distinctive nature of Jesus’ assembly. We are not trying to be new or trendy but ancient and faithful. Judgment belongs alone to God, but we are to be discerning. We should only be and do what pleases God.

One hymn that is certain to be sung in thousands of churches around the world on April 17<sup>th</sup> is Robert Lowry's "**Low In The Grave He Lay**" to which he wrote both words & tune. Lowry (1826-1899) is one of the luminaries of the golden age of the gospel song and among his many contributions to our hymnody are the following:

Savior, Thy Dying Love (tune)  
Shall We Gather At The River (words & music)  
I Need Thee Every Hour (tune)  
We're Marching To Zion (tune to chorus)  
Nothing But the Blood of Jesus (words & tune)  
All The Way My Savior Leads Me (tune)
