## Recipients of Holy Spirit Baptism

What is a point of debate is if the apostles received the baptism of the Spirit or if all those present in the upper room (Acts 1:15). Is the “all” in Acts 2:1 the one hundred twenty mentioned in Acts 1:15? If so, one might wonder why Christ did not speak to the one hundred twenty about this (cf. Acts 1:2ff) when he spoke of this event to the apostles before his death and ascension (Acts 1:3–5; cf. 11:16). This promise indicated that the intended recipients of Holy Spirit baptism were the apostles (cf. John 7:39). Luke also seemed to refer to the apostles in Acts 2:1 given the transition of contexts from 1:26.

The speaking in tongues “bewildered” those present in Jerusalem because they noticed them speaking in each of their languages (Acts 2:6–11). Each person heard “the mighty works of God” (Acts 2:11) as they were being proclaimed. This was meant to prove to them that Jesus was the Christ and that they needed salvation through him (Acts 2:22; cf. Heb. 2:3–4). Consequently, when Peter spoke to the house of Cornelius, the same manifestation occurred with similar effects. Peter and his companions “were amazed” (Acts 10:45; cf. vv. 28–29). This visible sign proved to the Jewish Christians that the Gentiles were also worthy of salvation (Acts 10:47–48).

These post-ascension accounts of baptism with the Spirit obtained the attention of those listening, convicted them of truth otherwise difficult to grasp (cf. Heb. 2:1–4), and showed God’s selection. Since salvation is from the Jews (John 4:22), one should not think it plausible that the same authority or ability be given to the Gentile recipients as that of the Jewish apostles. Christ was said to have had “the Spirit without measure” (John 3:34–35), thus indicating that God gave “all things into his hand.” However, the apostles did not receive the fullness of the Holy Spirit (cf. Eph. 3:2; 4:7; 2 Cor. 10:13) as Christ had. Therefore, God acted on the part of the Gentiles to prove to the Jews that all other races were worthy of salvation and that they were not to be excluded.

Although Peter linked the events at Pentecost and Cornelius’ household to Joel’s prophecy, he did not restrict them to that event. Neither did he advocate that the event on Pentecost was the beginning of the fulfillment of Joel’s prophecy. Peter said, “But this is what was uttered through the prophet Joel” (Acts 2:16). A retroactive comprehension of Joel’s prophecy may be warranted since the prophecy spoke to the era rather than a specific time or event. Therefore, the prophecy of Joel should not be limited to an understanding of Spirit baptism when earlier and later texts exhibit fulfillment as well (Luke 1–2). The only instances of Spirit baptism were those of the apostles at Pentecost and of Cornelius’ household.

Our congregational records are fairly thin during the Water Street years (1909-1949) and this is due to a number of factors, among which could be listed lack of money & lack of organization. There was no office, office equipment or office staff. Any church business was handled by local businessman and long-time church elder, Cecil Thurmond, at his office or his home. His PO box became the church's address for decades and his service to this church is incalculable!!

Upon the move to larger & more up-to-date facilities at 7<sup>th</sup> & Poplar in 1950, things took on a more professional character in large part thanks to William Medearis, pulpit minister from December '52 to December '55. An office was organized, equipment was purchased and office help was employed. It was during this time that we have the first real sense of collecting & preserving church history.
