Jesus gives the golden rule, which was meant to guide interpreting the Law (7:12). The golden rule parallels similar statements from other civilizations.

Watch yourself, my son, in everything you do, and discipline yourself in all your conduct. And what you hate, do not do to anyone. (Tobit 4:14–15; second century BC)

Let us show our generosity in the same manner that we would wish to have it bestowed on us. (Seneca, *De Beneficiis* 2.1.1; contemporary of Jesus)

What is hateful to you, do not do to your neighbor. That is the whole Torah. The rest is commentary. Go and learn! (Hillel, *b. Sabb.* 31a; 70 BC–AD 10)

Do not do unto others what you would not want others to do unto you. (Confucius, *Analects* 15.23)

Anything that might seem as if we should treat another in a certain way must be turned on ourselves and asked whether we'd wish to be treated in that way.

Truly, if we were to all live by this rule, our world would be a lot better off. I remember my daddy asking me what the root of sin was. I pondered on that question and couldn't come up with an answer. I looked at daddy and asked what his thoughts were. His reply, "Selfishness." As I've grown older, I agree with his assessment. Selfishness is what leads to sin. When we only care about ourselves, we act with our own interests in mind. Following the golden rule demands that we think of others first. Many of us were brought up to be so caring. After all, that's why many of us have manners. It's about considering others and respecting them. I think we would all agree that the world could use better manners.

Library Seek Ye First

Most evangelical Christians are very familiar with John Willard Peterson's 1961 song "*Seek ye First The Kingdom of God*" which is now universally sung wherever Christians meet. Peterson (1921-2006) was a luminary in Evangelical Christian music of the 1950s thru the 1970s. during which time he wrote over 1000 songs including "*This Is The Day That The Lord Hath Made*" as well as "*Jesus is Coming Again*" (Marvelous Message We Bring) # 727 in our hymnal.

Peterson attended the American Conservatory of Music as well as Moody Bible Institute and was associated for many years with the Singspiration organization.

In 1961, he compiled and edited *Great Hymns of the Faith* which became one of the major general line hymnals of the era. This hymnal contained 548 total hymns including 47 of Peterson's own compositions. He has been inducted int the Gospel Music Hall of Fame. As hymns go, "*Seek Ye First*" is a relatively new one!!!
