

Disputing Over Moses' Body



This writing was likely written in the first century BC or AD because it mentions the death of King Herod and other events in 4–3 BC. Initially written in Hebrew or Aramaic, the only copy today is a Latin manuscript from the sixth century AD, and scholars suggest that it was translated from a Greek copy of the story. Depending on your commentary, some will argue that this isn't a reference from this book but alludes to the scene in Zechariah 3:1–3. In contrast, others insist it is based on *Assumption*.

A Bible scholar from the third century named Origen sheds some light on this. While in Alexandria, Egypt—an educational city akin to Cambridge, Oxford, etc.—he wrote a work *Of the Principles*. He writes,

We have now to notice, agreeably to the statements of Scripture, how the opposing powers, or the devil himself, contends with the human race, inciting and instigating men to sin. And in the first place, in the book of Genesis, the serpent is described as having seduced Eve; regarding whom, in the work entitled The Ascension of Moses (a little treatise, of which the Apostle Jude makes mention in his Epistle), the archangel Michael, when disputing with the devil regarding the body of Moses, says that the serpent, being inspired by the devil, was the cause of Adam and Eve's transgression.

Our version doesn't contain the story, but Origen had an earlier copy that may have.

Some brethren find it problematic that an early Christian quotes from a work we no longer possess. It shouldn't. Especially if you've read your Bible. There are works mentioned that we no longer possess. There's the book of Jasher (Josh. 10:13; 2 Sam. 1:18), the Book of the Wars of the Lord (Num. 21:14), and others. Then again, Jude may have known of this story and used it as a preacher would quote from *The Chronicles of Narnia* or some other popularized work. Paul often quoted Greek poets. We may not know, but we do know that God inspired the writer to use it. That ought to be enough.

Elmer Leon Jorgenson's *Great Songs of the Church*, in its various editions, was used by the Water Street/7th & Poplar Street Church (previous locations of Glendale) for the longest period of time of any other hymnbook in our history. Display copies of each of our hymnbooks are contained in the glass display case just outside the conference room. We've used 7 different hymnals in our 115-year history.

The 1937 edition is the one that most older folks will recall having been used in our previous locations. It is the one with the blue buckram cover which led to the "old blue" label given by those who were very much attached to this incomparable hymnbook. Copies are still around if one searches for them. The Churches of Christ today are musically poorer for not having *Great Songs* available!
