## Betrayal and Abandon

At the Last Supper, Jesus proclaims that one of the disciples would betray him, and they were distressed over this (Matt. 26:22; Mark 14:19), arguing who it might be (Luke 22:23). Jesus says that it was the one dipping his hand in the bowl with him (Matt. 26:23; Mark 14:20). Matthew alone has Judas responding to Jesus, “Surely not I, Rabbi” (Matt. 26:25). Jesus told him to do quickly what he was doing. Still, the others thought he meant to buy what was needed for the holiday since Judas kept the money bag (John 13:27–29).

During the Passover meal, it was customary for the head of the family to lead them in its observance. Jesus assumes this position as head of the family by addressing his disciples as “little children” (John 13:33). The Jews were already known for how they loved one another: “The Jews are extremely loyal to one another, and always ready to show compassion” (Tac., *Hist.* 5.5). Yet, the newness of Jesus’ commandment is that they were to love one another as he loved them—“Greater love has no one than this, than to lay down one’s life for his friends” (John 15:13).

Matthew and Mark are unique in Jesus saying that they would run away, Matthew adding “tonight” (Matt. 26:31–32; Mark 14:27–28). He quotes Zechariah 13:7, which prophesied that the shepherd would be struck and the sheep would scatter. Meanwhile, Peter insisted that he would never abandon Jesus, so he told Peter that Satan had demanded to sift Peter as wheat (Luke 22:31). Even Satan is accountable to God’s sovereign will (cf. Job. 1:8–11; 2:3–6). Peter is shocked at the suggestion that he would be unfaithful, but Jesus has prayed for him, knowing that he will strengthen the brethren when he returns to Jesus.

## The Church's 2<sup>nd</sup> Most Important Book # 7

It comes as a surprise to many that Alexander Campbell's hymnal wasn't the only such book available. Because of several disagreements over style, several books came out during the mid to late 19<sup>th</sup> century and one of the leading hymnbook compilers of this era was a man named Amos Sutton Hayden (1813-1880).

Hayden was among other things a preacher, writer, music instructor and a song book publisher. His *History of the Disciples on The Western Reserve* (which we have in our library) was a landmark book. Sutton published the first compilation of sacred music for the use of the Restoration Movement churches to be used in what he called "social worship" settings.

He published the *Sacred Melodeon* in 1849, the *Hymnist* in 1863 as well as the *Christian Hymn & Tune Book* in 1870. He, among several others, concocted an alternate notation system which was used for a time but which proved to be too confusing for churches to adopt permanently. Although folks today don't know his name, he was a true Renaissance Man.
