You've heard the saying, "Give a man a fish, and he'll eat for a day; teach a man to fish, and he'll eat for a lifetime." Relative to God's word, we might express this principle this way: "Teach a man what the Bible says, and he has knowledge for a day; teach a man to study the Bible, and he has knowledge for a lifetime."

While preachers have a responsibility to "preach the word" and in so doing, to "convince, rebuke, exhort with all longsuffering and teaching" (2 Timothy 4:2), we need to realize that preaching the Word is more than simply telling the audience what's in the Word. It's also "empowering" each listener to study the Scriptures for himself, and to effectively interpret and use what he logically concludes using all the inspired writings (Psalm 139:17).

When Paul had taught Timothy all he had to teach, the apostle admonished him, "But you must continue in the things which you have learned and been assured of, knowing from whom you have learned them, and that from childhood you have known the Holy Scriptures, which are able to make you wise for salvation through faith which is in Christ Jesus" (2 Timothy 3:14-15).

Nothing we do today, will make God love us any more than He already does, and nothing we do today, will make Him love us any less."

The Work of the Kingdom

The oldest monarchy on the face of the earth is the Japanese monarchy. They have records dating back to 660 BC. Queen Elizabeth celebrated her platinum jubilee, a reign of 70 years. Hers is the longest of any British monarch and possibly any monarch ever. Many of us are intrigued by royalty because it's relatively unknown in our country. We began as a democratic republic, repudiating any notion of a monarch reigning over us. In the Great War, many monarchies crumbled in favor of more democratic governments, though some crumbled into a dictatorial one.

Imagine, for one second, that one person existed who'd rule with justice and integrity. Someone who never has to be second-guessed or criticized because His kingdom is the model on which every kingdom was built since the beginning of time. Alluding to Daniel 7:13-14, Jesus declared that all authority in heaven and on earth is His (Matt. 28:18-20). Here on earth, our King left instructions for His apostles that we are to carry on to this day. This is the final command that Jesus gave. In the Greek construction of this passage, "make disciples" is a subordinate participle. Everything else defines how a disciple is made. We are to go, baptize, and teach.

Last year we had 17 baptisms and 31 people become members of this body. As we reflect on having done the work of the kingdom, we can look forward to continuing that work while also making improvements as needed. If we measure success by numbers and results, it can be discouraging to not see higher numbers. Rather than viewing it that way, let's view it in another way—rather than being "successful," let's be faithful. As we faithfully serve our Lord, we either plant or water what's been planted. God, in his own time, will give the increase. We're called to be faithful in doing his work, and the results will follow.
