## As It Gets Hotter ...

Many people won't like me for saying this, but I prefer winter over summer. The main reason is that I like the cold weather more than the infernal heat we've been experiencing. Plus, I like to joke that hell is hot, so I want no part of it. All kidding aside, as it gets hotter, clothing is accommodated to the weather. For some folks, however, that means being clothed immodestly.

I realize that modesty may be a social construct. For example, people in the African desert may only have their loins covered, which is acceptable. But, who determines what is and isn't modest? The easy answer for we Christians is "God." Therefore, it should be safe to say that any sexualization of a person's body, male or female, through clothing would displease our Father.

As our children have grown, we've instilled them with standards of modesty that we believe wouldn't displease God. For example, when we took trips to the beach, we didn't post pictures of ourselves in bathing suits. Usually, our daughter would wear a cover and our son a shirt. Even at home, on several acres surrounded by woods, they still wear those when they swim. When we're in public, the dress must be as such that it's respectable. We never cared how "cute" an outfit might look. That wasn't the standard. Is it revealing body parts meant to be covered or in any way we'd think was inappropriate? Those were the questions we asked.

You may think I'm a bit stuffy if you're reading this. Folks today view wearing sexualized clothing as "empowering." This is the word we often hear about this kind of thing. I think it isn't empowering but demeaning to dress in a way that removes a person's inherent dignity by suggesting that their body is a tool for another's desires.

"Well, what about how others dress?" I can't control what anyone wears other my family. But, like Job, I can make a covenant with my eyes (Job 31:1) to not gaze at people in a way that moves one to lust. I've never wanted my wife or daughter viewed in a perverted way, nor for my son to view girls in the same way. What I suggest is that by our dress, we reveal our dignity. How we present ourselves reflects the respect we have for ourselves. For Christians, it also demonstrates our willingness to submit to God's will and glorify him, even with our clothing.

## LIBRARY E. Bailey **Old Brother Teddlie**

During my Lord's Supper remarks last Sunday, I made mention of one of Brother Tillit S. Teddlie's hymn that most of us learned as "When We Meet In Sweet Communion." Teddlie (1885-1987) was most often associated with Texas from which he edited about 12 hymnals and wrote around 100 songs.

In addition to "When We Meet In Sweet Communion," he also wrote "Worthy Art Thou" and "Heaven Holds All To Me."

In his 1980 book titled *Our Garden of Song*, Gene Finley included some material on Teddlie which some will find of interest. The book # for Finley's book in our collection is 245/Fin/1980.
