## Jesus' Final Passover

In Mark, these verses introduce the events surrounding the arrest, trial, and execution of Jesus. While the Pharisees are often Jesus' opponents, the chief priests and scribes plan to see him put to death. Initially, the authorities did not intend to arrest him during the festival because of the fear of the people (Luke 22:2) rioting (Matt. 26:5). Still, they would change plans and arrest him during the feast.

Luke is the only gospel that does not mention the woman's devotion to Jesus. John notes that Martha was serving Jesus at the meal, and Lazarus was there too. Mary, John writes, was the one showing Jesus this devotion by anointing him (John 12:2-3). John also identifies the complainer as Judas Iscariot (John 12:4). The oil used was aromatic and extracted from a root found in India. Hence, its preservation in the alabaster flask was necessary. The flask would have to be broken, and it was worth more than a year's wages. It's been suggested that this may have been a family heirloom used in a time of financial need, and if that's so, her act was like parting with one's savings. The custom was to anoint a guest's head at a meal, but this goes beyond the usual courtesy. Jesus uses this gesture to point to what is to come, but this is an act of great love and devotion for Mary. It is this undivided devotion to Jesus that we are to emulate.

Luke writes that "Satan entered Judas" (Luke 22:3), and Jesus later points this out (John 13:2, 27). "Satan" comes from Hebrew and means "adversary." The term isn't exclusively used for the devil, which means "slanderer." It often appears with the definite article and is only once used as a proper name in the Old Testament (1 Chron. 21:1). Every other occurrence in the Old Testament would be better translated as "the adversary."

Next, preparations are made for the Passover meal. Luke includes a little more than the others (Luke 22:24-30). John notes the washing of feet and the example Jesus left. Doing this was taboo for a Jewish teacher because he essentially took on the position of an enslaved person, perhaps one who isn't even Jewish. Rabbis stressed humility, but a Jewish teacher could never humble himself to the point of relinquishing his superior position (*y. Sanh.* 11.3). The type of garment Jesus wears refers to a long towel fastened at the shoulder, which allowed him to gird himself and dry the disciples' feet. Seutonius wrote that Caligula humiliated senators by having them wait on him in similar attire (*Cal.* 26.2).

## **The Church's 2<sup>nd</sup> Most Important Book # 5**

**Barton Warren Stone** (1772-1844) is forever honored as one of this country's premier proponents of New Testament Christianity on the frontier. In 1829, he, along with Thomas Adams, issued the *Christian Hymn-Book, Compiled & Published at the Request of the Miami Christian Conference* (340 words-only hymns beginning with "Come, Ye Sinners, Poor And Needy")

In 1833, Stone and **John T. Johnson** (1788-1856) issued a second edition which sold for 37.5 cents per copy. The book sold about 3000 copies- a phenomenal number for that time, before it was merged into Campbell's hymnal in 1834

**David Purviance** (1766-1847) edited a small hymnal in 1815 called the *Christian Hymn Book*.

**Rice Haggard** (1769-1819) issued *A Selection of Christian Hymns* in Lexington, KY in 1818.

All of the above mentioned hymn books attest to the fact that these very early preachers on the frontier held congregational singing as supremely important to their congregations.
