Psalms 1 compares two types of people. It describes the person who is ungodly, a sinner, and a scoffer. This person is like chaff which the wind drives away. The other person is the one whose delight is in the law of the Lord. This person thinks about, or meditates, on the law day and night. This person is compared to a tree that is planted by the river and because of this has a constant source of life. The person thus oriented gives fruit and does not wither in tough times (times of drought). In I Peter 1:6-8 Peter talks of tough times and uses the illustration of gold that is purified by fire to compare the tests that life gives us in order to strengthen and purify our faith. Peter makes 3 statements to consider. 1: Your faith is more precious than gold (I Pet 1:7). Jesus would say, "what does it profit you to gain the whole world and lose your soul?" How much time and energy do I spend nourishing and exercising my faith? Is my treasure in earthly things, or heavenly things?

2: The object of your faith is to the praise, honor and glory of Jesus Christ (I Pet 1:7). Is my heart full of gratitude to the one who gave His own life on my account? Do my actions show that love through obedience and love for my neighbor?

3: The end (objective) of your faith is the salvation of your soul (I Pet 1:9). Is the objective of my faith sustaining me in difficult times? Is my life rooted in the water that God promises and supplies? In short, am I a tree or chaff?

After the Crucifixion

The Guarded Tomb (Matt. 27:61–66): After seeing where the tomb was, they adjourned for the Sabbath, which began at sundown on Friday. They counted time differently than we do. When we think of three days, we think of three twenty-four-hour periods. They, on the other hand, didn't think like that. Friday was counted as a day, the Sabbath another day, and the first day of the week was the third day. It wasn't three complete twenty-four-hour periods. Matthew informs us that one of the claims was that the disciples took Jesus' body. Yet, the fact that he appeared to hundreds of disciples over the course of forty days before his ascension debunks that claim. Two forms of security are given to the tomb—a Roman seal and a guard.

Sunday Morning: Earthquakes are not uncommon in Palestine. The Jordan Rift Valley is part of a large fault zone that stretches from the Gulf of Aqaba for over 683 miles to the Taurus range. Yet, this earthquake is indicative of an angelic arrival. Matthew notes that an angel was outside, while Mark notes one was inside. Luke mentions two angels, which may account for the confusion between the accounts. When Paul mentioned even an angel proclaiming a different gospel (Gal. 1:8), we must remember that angels informed various people about parts of Jesus' life. Here, the angel declares that Jesus has risen.

Many Jews at this time believed in a resurrection. They drew it partly from Isaiah (26:19; 53:11) and Daniel (12:2). This belief became more prevalent and explained in the period between the Testaments, but one common theme was that resurrection was reserved solely for the godly. A prayer during this period called the *Amidah* ("standing") consists of numerous blessings. The second petition of this daily prayer, repeated even to this day, ends, "Blessed are you, O Lord, who bring the dead to life." By the time of Jesus, disbelief in the resurrection was somewhat unorthodox. The Sadducees are noted for this disbelief, which was often a contention point between them and the Pharisees.

The Church's 2nd Most Important Book # 17

In addition to Elmer Leon Jorgenson, the other name that exerted the most influence over the singing of the Churches of Christ in the 20th century was certainly that of L. O. Sanderson (1901-1992). Based in Memphis much of time, he became closely associated with the Gospel Advocate Company in Nashville.

During his years of editing their hymnals, he produced the *Christian Hymns* series beginning with the 1935 edition. Subsequent editions appeared in 1948 and 1965. It was the 1948 book that was most popular throughout much of the country east of the Mississippi and this is the one that most folks living today remember in the pews of countless churches in our region. The University Church used the 1948 book for several years when I first started leading their singing.

Sanderson also wrote several books on singing and the rudiments of music. Locals might remember that his son, Leon Sanderson, came to Murray a few years back to be part of that year's Sing & Rejoice.
