### **Turning His Attention to the Cross**

(Matthew 16:21–17:13)

#### **PROVIDENCE**

In our continued study of the providence of God on Wednesday evening, this coming Wednesday, we will be summing up chapter 2, which is entitled "Is Perhaps".

Some questions that we will be discussing:

- 1. What kinds of things besides providence may hinder our plans?
- 2. What objections do some raise to the that anvone might providentially hindered from doing something good?
- 3. What are some of the implications of James' admonition, "You ought to say, if the Lord wills, we will live and do this or that"?
- 4. What does Proverbs say about human plans?
- Why recognizing God's providential activity in specific instances "perhaps"?
- 6. Why did Paul think providence "perhaps" brought about the circumstance with Philemon Onesimus?
- 7. And how did providence "perhaps" work in the infancy of Moses, and with what purpose?

It marks a pivotal moment when Jesus shifts his attention to his crucifixion. The Jewish leaders, not the Romans, put Jesus to death despite it being at the behest of the Romans. Each gospel author makes this point clear. Yet, many would later join the disciples on Pentecost and after. Luke records six predictions of Jesus' death, or "passion," as it's commonly called. The term "passion" means "suffering," deriving ultimately from a Latin word meaning "to endure, undergo." Hence, the Passion of the Christ.

Mark and Luke have Jesus refer to himself as the "Son of Man," a messianic designation that God intended for Jesus to fulfill (Dan. 7:13-14). The exaltation of the Son of Man pointed to the rule of God, but they did not expect him to suffer before then. The belief in resurrection after the third day was common in Jewish thought (Hos. 6:2; Jonah 1:17). "In the third day, he will raise us up, and we shall live in his sight" (B. Sanh. 97a).

Following these statements, Jesus calls his disciples again. They must deny themselves, take up their crosses, and follow Jesus. Taking up one's cross means risking suffering and death. Whenever one was condemned to crucifixion, they carried the crossbeam, not the entire cross, because the vertical beam was usually already in place at the crucifixion site. Essentially, live as one condemned because if approved in this life, one will lose their life. On the other hand, condemnation in this life means receiving eternal life in God's kingdom.

When we read of the coming of Jesus, we mostly envision the second coming. He is speaking about his ascension, to which Daniel 7:13–14 refers. It can't have had to do with his second coming because those present wouldn't see death until they saw his kingdom come.

#### Library E. Bailey **Located or Not?**

Throughout the centuries, folks who truly desire to follow the NT in faith & practice, have often disagreed on some of the finer details of the NT church.

In the last 200 years of the Restoration Movement here in America, one issue that has led to considerable controversy is the question of "located" vs "itinerant" preachers. In some sectors, this has led to heated discussions, in spite of the fact that the NT does not promote either of these systems.

Basically, a "located" preacher is one of lives and works among one local church on a daily basis. Water Street's first located preacher was actually William Fletcher Etheridge who lived from 1872-1951 and served the Murray church from 1912-1914.

Following his tenure, Water Street had a somewhat long stretch of part-time or "itinerant" preachers up through the end of the Great Depression and into WW2. We owe an eternal debt of gratitude to those men who served so faithfully often with very little thanks or appreciation.
