Faulty Arguments for Infant Baptism

In Matthew 19:13–14, placing hands on children for a blessing has a long history in Israel. It was primarily for conferring a blessing from one generation to another (Gen. 48:14; Num. 27:18). Luke is unique in stating that infants were also brought. Some have argued, from Jesus' words here, that this justifies infant baptism, but that's not the point. However, on that point, infant baptism may have been observed in the late second century but was disputed in some places in the third century.

He [Jesus] came to save all through himself; all, I say, who through him are reborn in God: infants, and children, and youths, and old men. Therefore he passed through every age, becoming an infant for infants, sanctifying infants; a child for children, sanctifying those who are of that age . . . [so that] he might be the perfect teacher in all things, perfect not only in respect to the setting forth of truth, perfect also in respect to relative age (*Against Heresies* 2:22:4 [AD 189]).

According to everyone's condition and disposition, and also his age, the delaying of baptism is more profitable, especially in the case of little children. For why is it necessary — if [baptism itself] is not necessary — that the sponsors should be thrust into danger? For they may either fail of their promise by death, or they may be mistaken by a child's proving of wicked disposition. . . . They that understand the weight of baptism will rather dread the receiving of it, than the delaying of it. An entire faith is secure of salvation! (*Concerning Baptism* 18 [AD 200])

Other mentions of the practice appear after this period, but one who was prolific in his writings about the matter was Cyprian of Carthage, who lived in the mid-third century. Other arguments favoring the practice include household baptisms in Acts and Paul's equating baptism with circumcision in Colossians 2:11–12. No biblical case can be made, though some try because faith and confession were prerequisites of salvation and baptism (immersion).

Awaiting The Trumpet Call

How many documented cemeteries are there in Calloway County? In 1995, J. H. Churchill Funeral Home had printed, by permission, a Calloway County Cemetery Map compiled over many years by John B. Cavitt (1924-2009).

Cavitt's monumental research was and still is the first effort of its kind and, upon bringing his initial research to completion, he had identified 212 cemeteries which are numbered on his map. After 1995, Cavitt told me that he was still finding previously undocumented burial grounds which did not make it on the original map.

Many very early 19th century burials were done on private property and there were often only one or two graves at that location. State & local records in the early years were haphazard at best and hundreds, perhaps thousands, of early grave stones are long gone.

There is a framed copy of the map along with a framed legend that lists all 212 by both cemetery number as well as by cemetery name on display in the office until such time as we can locate an appropriate place to hang them for public examination.
