## Even A Broken Clock Is Right Twice A Day

In his commentary on Titus, John Calvin wrote, “All truth is from God; and consequently, if wicked men have said anything that is true and just, we ought not to reject it; for it has come from God.” A proverbial example of considering all viewpoints on any argument is: “If one gives an answer before he hears, it is his folly and shame” (Prov. 18:13; cf. James 1:19). Some Christians are opposed to reading material by certain groups of people, but I confess that I’ve learned a lot from those with whom I disagree. One of my teachers used to say about material other than Scripture, “Eat the fish. Throw away the bone.”

Growing up in Tarsus, Paul would have been privy to primary, grammar, and rhetorical school before going to Jerusalem to receive his rabbinical training. Whether he endured the breadth of all three stages of Roman education in Tarsus is unknown. Still, his training appears to be informed by pagan works that are quoted within Scripture.

Paul believed that no matter where truth came from, it could be used in service to God. “For the weapons of our warfare *are* not carnal but mighty in God for pulling down strongholds, casting down arguments and every high thing that exalts itself against the knowledge of God, bringing every thought into captivity to the obedience of Christ” (2 Cor. 10:4–5). Yet, just because he was willing to entertain a thought didn’t mean that it was worth keeping.

### The Voice of an Angel

One of the songs that used to be sung widely among Churches of Christ was "*Whispering Hope*" (#497 in our book). The words to "Soft as the Voice of An Angel" were written in 1868 by Alice Hawthorne, one of several pseudonyms used by Septimus Winner (1827-1905).

While the song has been around for 155 years, it was never included in any edition of Jorgenson's GREAT SONGS series from 1921-1986. It was, however, included in all three editions (1935, 1948 and 1966) of L. O. Sanderson's CHRISTIAN HYMNS, published by the Gospel Advocate Company of Nashville. Sanderson's song books were widely used, especially east of the Mississippi which accounts for this song's popularity in our part of the country.
