Jesus In Jerusalem

Zechariah 9:9 foretells the coming Messianic king, Jesus, “Rejoice greatly, O daughter of Zion! Shout, O daughter of Jerusalem! Behold, your King is coming to you; He is just and having salvation, lowly and riding on a donkey, a colt, the foal of a donkey.” This is precisely what Matthew records as fulfilling in 21:5. The only other time clothing is laid before a king appears in 2 Kings 9:13—“Then each man hastened to take his garment and put it under him on the top of the steps; and they blew trumpets, saying, ‘Jehu is king!’” Immediately before this, Elisha the prophet had sent a fellow prophet to anoint Jehu as king, and Jehu’s task was to strike down the house of Ahab for their sins in killing God’s prophets and servants. If we parallel these two accounts, this placing of clothing on the ground as Jesus enters Jerusalem was a recognition of Christ as anointed king. *Ho-shee-ah-na*: “Save, we pray.”

(Matthew 21:18–19, 12–13; Mark 11:12–18; Luke 19:45–48): Jesus appears to have spent his nights in Bethany and his days in Jerusalem. They are only two miles apart. Jesus curses a fig tree, and we later see it wither (Matthew 21:19–22; Mark 11:19–26; Luke 21:37–38). The markets for sacrificial animals were on the Mount of Olives, and they were only relocated to the temple grounds around AD 30. Sacrificial animals were needed, and this wasn’t what Jesus protested. Because he called the moneychangers a den of thieves, his protest may have stemmed from the high rates they charged for currency exchange. The moneychangers were allowed to set up in the temple compound only five days before the temple tax was due, so that we could place this within those five days, about two weeks before Passover.

(John 12:20–50): The start of this has Greeks wishing to see Jesus, but he seems to ignore the request in light of his impending suffering. They were likely God-fearers (cf. Acts 17:4) who came to Jerusalem to worship. God-fearers were attracted to the Jewish religion but had not yet fully converted. Cornelius, the Roman centurion, was one such God-fearer. After seeking out Jesus, he replies to them about his impending glorification—likely referring to Isaiah 52:13. Rabbis often used a kernel of wheat to illustrate a principle of life: “If the grain of wheat, which is buried naked, sprouts forth in many robes, how much more so the righteous, who are buried in their raiment” (*b. Sanh. 90b*)? This was concerning the death and resurrection of a person. Being troubled, Jesus wants to be saved from what lies ahead, but knows that’s why he has come. Looking beyond his own needs, he wishes to glorify God.
