In the Garden (Part 1)

The Prayer in the Garden: Matthew and Mark record that the conclusion of the Passover meal entailed singing the hymn before going to the Mount of Olives. This was likely the Hallel Psalms (113–118). Hallel means “praise.” Hallelujah means “Praise Yah.” Gethsemane means “olive press.” It was an orchard of olive trees with a press for extracting oil that gave the place its name. It’s just outside the Eastern wall in the Kidron Valley. Taking his inner three, Peter, James, and John, Jesus retreats to a point in the garden, leaving them to go pray. Yet, in a human moment, Jesus expresses his despair (Mark 14:34)—an allusion to Psalm 42:6. One point of discussion is: since Jesus was God in the flesh, why would he, being all-knowing, ask God to remove the cup from him? More than that, the point is that Jesus asked for relief but entrusted the matter to God by asking that his will be done. He returns to find his disciples sleeping, and Peter had earlier promised he wouldn’t stumble in his faith (Mark 14:29). Yet here he is, sleeping. Jesus addresses him by Simon, like at the beginning. He was saying they were where they started when they first met. What was their temptation? I believe it may have been what they did when things got hard—they ran (defected). Once more, he goes to pray and returns to find them sleeping, but he doesn’t rebuke them this time.

The Arrest of Jesus: John states that Judas came with a detachment of soldiers (John 18:3). This may have been a mix of temple guards and Roman soldiers, but a detachment was 600. Romans often used large numbers when protecting prisoners, especially if they feared the prisoner had a following large enough to cause a rebellion. Paul was guarded by 470 men while under arrest (Acts 23:23). Once Judas betrays him with a kiss, he’s arrested, but Peter draws either a long knife or a short sword. There are two words for the sword, one being the short, concealable sword used here. Peter strikes Malchus (John 18:10), but Jesus rebukes him, allowing them to take him into custody. They all run and desert him (Mark 14:50). Mark alone mentions a man in a garment who flees when taken hold of, leaving his garment behind. This is likely an allusion to Amos 2:16 and Genesis 39:12.
