## Paul's Life After Acts

Since we'll be concluding 2 Timothy, Paul's final letter, I wanted to give a historical snapshot at his final years beyond what Scripture records. Paul spent two years in Rome as a prisoner and preached the gospel without hindrance (*Eccl. Hist.* 2.22; cf. Acts 28:30). He wrote 2 Timothy from Rome and described what happened and what awaited him (*Ibid.*; cf. 2 Tim. 4:16–18). Paul well knew that he was about to be martyred for the faith (2 Tim. 4:6). Luke concluded Acts at Paul's first trial before the Jews because he may not have been allowed to be with him in his first Roman trial (2 Tim. 4:16). However, only Luke was with Paul in the end (2 Tim. 4:11). As Nero became more depraved he lashed out at the Christians in Rome. Eusebius (church historian) writes this: “It is recorded that in [Nero's] reign that Paul was beheaded in Rome itself” (*Eccl. Hist.* 2.25).

The date of Paul's death would have to be around AD 64–65, because that's when the persecution of Christians began and around the time that Nero set fire to Rome and blamed Christians as his scapegoats (Tacitus *Annals* 15.44.3–8; Suetonius *Nero* 16.2). This timeline has proven to be problematic for scholars, but explanations have been given to reconcile the data—one of which is that Paul was released after the two years' imprisonment mentioned in Acts and was later imprisoned for preaching and then beheaded.

A couple of sources written shortly after Paul's life give the following insight.

Because of jealousy and strife Paul showed the way to the prize for patient endurance. After he had been seven times in chains, had been driven into exile, had been stoned, and had preached in the east and in the west, he won the genuine glory for his faith, having taught righteousness to the whole world and having reached the farthest limits of the west. Finally, when he had given his testimony before the rulers, he thus departed from the world and went to the holy place, having become an outstanding example of patient endurance. (*1 Clement* 5.5–7)

You are the highway of those who are being killed for God's sake; you are fellow initiates of Paul, who was sanctified, who was approved, who is deservedly blessed—may I be found in his footsteps when I reach God!—who in every letter remembers who in Christ Jesus. (Ignatius *Eph.* 12.2)

### Bicentennial Minute

Of the congregations that exist today, the county church that began earliest is thought to have been New Concord. The date most often given for its establishment is 1845 but that is based upon scant concrete historical documents and historians believe that it was established even earlier given that Concord (under an earlier name) was one of the earliest established communities in the county.

In nearby Henry County, the Blood River church was established in 1842. Two very early preachers in Henry County who also heavily influenced the church in Calloway were Dr. John R. McCall (1803-1866) and John R. Howard, both of whom later moved on out of the area. A comprehensive history of the Blood River church was done by Don Fodge in 2012 and this 282-page detailed history is then finest such history of any church around!
