### Golden Rule

(Matthew 7:12)

A Samaritan (normally, a “enemy” of the Jews (cf. John 4:9) came by. He saw a fellow human in need and was moved with compassion (Luke 10:33). He tended the injured man’s wounds, set him on his own donkey, and conveyed him to a nearby inn where, amazingly, he paid for his lodging and pledged even more! (Luke 10:35). The Samaritan’s code of ethics was this: “But for the grace of God, I could be in agony by the roadside. What would I desire if our circumstances were reversed?”

#### Silver Rule

As the man lay wounded, unable to help himself, presently a Jewish priest came by, and then later, a Levite (one who served the priests in temple ceremonies). Both, crossed to the opposite side of the road, and hastened their steps. They did not kick the afflicted Jew; they did not rifle his pockets; they simply passed on. They were the “silver-rule” men.

From these two illustrated “rules” of human conduct, which one (or ones) do we incorporate in our daily lives? Have you ever considered that hurting someone comes in the way of not helping someone?

## The Process of Making Scripture

The Bible wasn’t put together until centuries after all the writings were collected, but some writings remained as a single book (e.g., Law of Moses, the Minor Prophets [known as the book of the twelve]). How did this process occur? How and who created the Bible is remarkable and something that isn’t required to know but is very enlightening.

Allow me, first, to give you a timeline of pertinent events as it relates to writing altogether and the Bible.

3200 BC — Writing began in Sumer through pictographic means.

3000 BC — Egyptian hieroglyphs were developed.

2100 BC — Abraham lived around this time.

1800 BC — An alphabet is created in Egypt.

1500 BC — Moses lived around this time.

1200 BC — Ugaritic, a language from Ugarit—a northwestern area in Syria—is used, and Exodus 15 and Judges 5 have stylistic patterns that resemble them. These similarities lead linguists to conclude that these two chapters are the oldest in the Bible and date to 1100–1200 BCE.

1000 BC — The monarchical period of Israel’s history begins.

1000–900 BC — The earliest Hebrew inscription on a potsherd is discovered and is dated to this period (Khirbet Qeiyafa ostrakon).

516→ BC — We have manuscripts dating to this period, known as the Second Temple Period, with the oldest dating to the late 4th century BC.

250→ BC — Dead Sea Scrolls

This timeline provides us a rough idea and overview of what we know about written communication. This information is the result of linguists, philologists, archaeology, and other related areas of study.

Materials used in writing were stone (Exod. 34:1, 28; Deut. 27:2–3), clay (Ezek. 4:1), wood (Is. 30:8; Hab. 2:2), and leather (Jer. 36:23). Additionally, papyrus leaves were mostly that upon which the New Testament was written. These plants grew along the Nile River and had been used as far back as 3000 BC but became common among the Greeks and Romans for making a book (codex) or books (codices). The average roll was 30 feet long and 9–10 inches high. Scribes would write on one side mostly, and occasionally on both sides (cf. Rev. 5:1). Animal skins, referred to as either vellum or parchment, were another common material used in the making of a letter. Stay tuned for more!
