GIVE BLOOD

Regarding Satan's origin and fall, first, from the Scriptures, Isaiah 14:12–15 has been interpreted from early centuries as a tale of the devil's rebellion. This passage explains why Satan is often referred to as "Lucifer" despite Isaiah stating that he wrote of the king of Babylon. In the first half of the third century, Origen acknowledged that the context of Isaiah's passage referred to the Babylonian king and that no human being is ever said to have fallen from heaven as Isaiah recorded (*On First Principles* 4.3.9). From this and other points, Origen suggested that the person under discussion could not have been exclusively the king of Babylon. This person was Satan, and Origen linked Isaiah's "fallen from heaven" reference to what Christ had said in Luke's Gospel, "Behold, I see Satan fallen from heaven like lightning" (Luke 10:18). In Isaiah's passage, Origen saw a deeper meaning than the original context of the verses, which early Christians were often given to do (e.g., Matthew's Gospel).

The passage in Ezekiel 28:11–15 was also used by early church theologians to describe Satan's fall. Writing in the mid-fourth century, Cyril of Jerusalem read Ezekiel's passage demonstrating that Satan was once an archangel based on the description of the figure Ezekiel gave. Though an archangel, he became "Satan" by becoming God's adversary (*Cat. Lect.* 2.4). Toward the close of the fourth century, Ambrose of Milan employed the Ezekiel passage to communicate Satan's origin as being in Eden, God's garden. Despite Ezekiel speaking about the king of Tyre, Ambrose believed that the king of Tyre stood for the devil (*On Paradise* 2.9). Before the first quarter of the fifth century, Jerome and Augustine also saw Satan in Ezekiel's verses. Other uninspired writings elaborate more on Satan.

There are other writings that aren't inspired that reflect the early Jewish/Christian views. However, if one wants to interpret it alike is another matter. It's certainly interesting to see how those close to the time of our Lord viewed matters.

## **The Church's 2<sup>nd</sup> Most Important Book # 6**

In May of 1828, Alexander Campbell brought his first hymnal – *Psalms, Hymns, And Spiritual Songs Adapted To The Christian Religion*. The original book contained 125 hymns among various other worship aids. As was the custom of the day, each hymn had a metrical abbreviation at the head of each poem and sold for 37.5 cents per copy.

A second edition was issued in 1829 and a third in 1832 – both from Campbell's home in Bethany, VA. Discussions were held with a view to combine Campbell's hymnal with Stone's but, due to several disagreements, a compromise edition was issued in 1834. From 1834 to 1843, five editions were published – all under the exclusive ownership of Campbell and, in 1848, the hymnal sold an astounding 100,000 copies!

Thus, was launched the single most important hymnal issued for the Restoration Movement in the 19<sup>th</sup> century. Numerous editions, revisions and formats were printed throughout the century. But Campbell was faced with some competition in the hymnal business.
