## The Resurrection of Lazarus

In times of uncertainty and challenge there is a song that brings me comfort and peace, and I hope it does you as well!!

### **"This World Is Not My Home"**

1. **Temporality of Earthly Life:** The song emphasizes that life on Earth is temporary, encouraging listeners to recognize that their true home lies beyond this world.

2. **Heavenly Hope:** It expresses a hopeful longing for a future in heaven, where believers will find peace and fulfillment free from earthly troubles.

3. **Alienation:** The lyrics convey a sense of being an outsider in this world, reflecting feelings of discomfort and a desire for a place of belonging.

4. **Faith and Spiritual Journey:** The song underscores the importance of faith in navigating life's challenges, reinforcing the belief that a heavenly reward awaits those who remain steadfast.

5. **Endurance Through Struggles:** It encourages perseverance through life's difficulties, reminding listeners that their struggles are temporary compared to the eternal joy promised in the afterlife.

Overall, the themes center on the hope of eternal life, spiritual resilience, and the longing for a divine home.

Having spoken of himself as the Good Shepherd that lays down his life for his sheep (10:11–18), Jesus now risks his life to give life to Lazarus (11:8, 45–53; 8:59; 10:31). Since we studied the story of the rich man and Lazarus last week, it's appropriate to point out that Lazarus means "helped." He resides in Bethany near Jerusalem, two miles east of the city (11:18), and returning would be dangerous. Mary and Martha are likely the same as in Luke 11:38–42, but Mary anoints the feet of the Lord in the next chapter. She is not the same as Mary Magdalene, who has often been accused of having been a harlot.

Mary Magdalene was accused of being a prostitute (John Chrysostom, *Homilies on John* 62.1; fourth century), and Pope Gregory the Great, in AD 591, solidified this understanding. Some acquaint her with the sinful woman and the unnamed woman take in adultery in Luke 7, while other spurious texts suggest that she was Jesus' wife (e.g., *The Gospel of Mary*; second century). Luke only points out that she was numbered among other women whom Jesus had freed from possession and infirmities. She must also have been a woman of means, as she is among those who financed Jesus' ministry (Luke 8:1–3). She was also present at the crucifixion and one of the women who discovered the empty tomb.

After receiving the message of Lazarus' illness, Jesus waited another two days. Lazarus may have already died by this time, and his delay would ensure that nothing was amiss when he raised him from the dead (11:15). Rabbinical sources suggest that Jews believed that a person's spirit lingered near the body for three days (*Gen. Rab.* 50.10), so Jesus' arrival on day four only further demonstrates how miraculous this will be (11:17). Martha's agreement with Jesus about the resurrection highlights that this was a Jewish belief (11:23–24).

When Mary comes to Jesus, she is weeping. The term used here means to sometimes wail or howl in the oriental style of grief, but it's unclear if that's what she did. We read twice that Jesus groaned in his spirit (11:33, 38). This shows the humanity in Christ because the phrase suggests struggling to maintain self-control. A different word, however, is used for Jesus' weeping (11:35). It denotes more of shedding a tear or the eyes tearing up. When they reach the tomb, Martha believes the effort is futile given the time that has passed (11:39). Then they witness one of the greatest miracles ever—Lazarus is raised from the dead. Then, the leaders plotted to kill Jesus and look for him during the Passover.
