## Priestly Services

From the very beginning, God intended for humanity to serve as priests. When the man is placed in the garden of Eden, God tells him to "tend and keep it" (Gen. 2:15). We likely think of landscaping and horticultural work when we read that, but the English translation of the Hebrew terms doesn't reflect their technicality. These two words, "tend" and "keep," are technical terms used in the work of the tabernacle in Numbers 3:7-10. *Shomra* is the word given as "keep" in Genesis 2:15, and in the passage from Numbers, it's translated as "attend" three times (vv. 7, 8, 10). *Obdah* is "tend" in Genesis 2:15 and is translated as "do the work" in Numbers 3:7-8. Therefore, the work of a priest was maintaining sacred space—keeping it from becoming polluted. Adam and Eve failed at that, so they were exiled from Eden. Yet, the priesthood of God's people hasn't passed away as much as we might think.

The Book of Hebrews views the assembly and worship in priestly terms. The priestly organization hasn't been abolished but follows a new forefather. Rather than our priesthood being Aaronic, it is after the order of Melchizedek (Heb. 7:20-28). We, collectively Christians, are a royal priesthood (1 Peter 2:9; Rev. 1:6; 5:10). Our High Priest is Christ our Lord who serves in the actual tabernacle of heaven—unlike the Aaronic priesthood that served the copy and shadow of the real on earth (cf. Heb. 9:1-10)—as our liturgist (Heb. 8:1-6).

When we assemble as God's priests to worship, we come literally to heaven itself, the Mount Zion of the city of God, along with angels and those who've gone before us (Heb. 12:22-24). We can look to heaven to determine our worship, and the most specific passage about heavenly worship is given in Revelation 4-5, where praises and prayers are offered, where the scroll of the Word of God is present, opened, and the Words of God are given. We also see the Lord's altar a little later, under which are the souls of the slain martyrs (Rev. 6:9-11)—a different form from which we observe the sacrificial meal that's the Lord's Supper (cf. Heb. 13:10).

## OREGON TRAIL

Folks back here in the Bible Belt don't usually think of Oregon as having much to do with the Restoration Movement. In reality, Oregon was one of the success stories of the movement in the mid 19<sup>th</sup> century.

Dr. Jerry Rushford, retired professor at Pepperdine, wrote the definitive history of the movement as it moved westward. His 550-page book, issued in 1997, is a prodigious piece of research into the vast numbers of Christians who left Kentucky, Tennessee and other points east to follow the Oregon Trail.

**Christians on The Oregon Trail** focuses primarily on the period of 1842-1882 when folks were pouring into the territory & state and establishing churches. Oregon was granted statehood in 1859 and, for some years thereafter, the Restoration Movement was the largest religious group in the state. (more next week)
