### What now?

Baptism signifies the end of a life of habitual sinning and the beginning of a new life devoted to righteousness. "... Denying ungodliness and worldly lusts, we should live soberly, righteously, and godly in the present age, looking for the blessed hope and glorious appearing of our great God and Savior Jesus Christ, who gave Himself for us, *that He might redeem us from every lawless deed* and purify for Himself His own special people, *zealous for good works*" ([Titus 2:11-14](#)).

The teachings of the entire Bible—both Old and New Testaments—become our guide to life. The New Testament explains how we should apply Old Testament teachings under the New Covenant.

No longer can we live however we want, ignoring God's instructions. Jesus made this abundantly clear: "Not everyone who says to Me, 'Lord, Lord,' shall enter the kingdom of heaven, but *he who does the will of My Father in heaven*. Many will say to Me in that day, 'Lord, Lord, have we not prophesied in Your name, cast out demons in Your name, and done many wonders in Your name?' And then I will declare to them, 'I never knew you; depart from Me, *you who practice lawlessness!*'" ([Matthew 7:21-23](#)). We are to live lawfully, not lawlessly!

## Temple Imagery in 1 Corinthians

The motif of Paul's call for exclusion from the community concerned the temple's sanctity (3:16–17). The curse pronounced in 1 Corinthians 5:5 is akin to the curse formulas of Deuteronomy 7:26 and 13:14–18 (note "destruction"). Exclusion from the community for transgressions was for purity (Exod. 12:15, 19; 30:33; 31:14; et. al.). However, earlier in the Bible, exclusion was related to ceremonial practices and their transgression, while the post-exilic period expanded the exclusion to include moral requirements.

A stark parallel is seen between 1 Corinthians 5:1 and Deuteronomy 22:30. Paul's temple imagery (3:16–17) mirrors that of Jeremiah's (7:4; Exod. 25:8; 29:45). The restrictions upon the temple are likely taken from Numbers 3:10, 38; 4:20; 19:20. Appropriate judgment served as a feature of discipline texts. When Achan transgressed the Lord and kept some of the spoil, Joshua told him the Lord would destroy him (Josh. 7:25; Lev. 26:23–25; 40–42).

The holiness principle was certainly what Paul had in mind, but he utilized it within the backdrop of temple imagery. The temple text of 3:16–17 was regarding the corporate body, while 6:19 was regarding an individual. Paul often employed an anticipatory lesson for a later discussion in his epistles so that the temple text of chapter 3 may be linked to chapter 5, showing that the former served as preparation to receive the latter.

The Old Testament often cited stories that linked temple cleansing and restoration (2 Chron. 29:5, 35). After this restoration, King Hezekiah called upon the people to celebrate the Passover (30:1). Josiah did the same (35:10–19; 2 Kings 23:1–23) as did Ezra (6:13–22). Interestingly enough, at the beginning of Jesus' ministry (John 2:12–22) and at its close (Matt. 21:12–13; Mark 11:15–18; Luke 19:45–47), Jesus too cleansed the temple and observed the Passover (cf. 1 Cor. 5:6–8).

## Library Kindly Entreating

A gospel song that used to be widely sung among Churches of Christ is W.A. Ogden's "**Seeking The Lost, Yes, Kindly Entreating**" (# 624 in our hymnal).

William Augustine Ogden (1841-1897) was an American composer, chiefly of church music, who led a varied career as choir director at various colleges and as a compiler of song books. Both words & music to "**Seeking The Lost**" were written in 1886 and, despite being relatively unsung in most fellowships, has been a special favorite of Churches of Christ and has appeared in virtually all hymnals published for Churches of Christ in the past 120-140 years.

Among Ogden's other contributions to our hymnody are words & music to "**Where He Leads I'll Follow**," and the music to "**Hark! 'Tis The Shepherd's Voice I Hear**," which is likely more widely known than any of his others.
