The Dual Purpose of Laying on of Hands.

The book of Acts records the laying on of hands within differing contexts. One context was that of appointment to ministry within the church (cf. Acts 6:1-6; 13:1-3; 1 Tim. 4:14; cf. 14:23). This context was usually predicated by prophecy or some other act of the Holy Spirit that revealed God's will for those selected for ministerial tasks. Within this process, the local church is witnessed as participating in the selection (Acts 6:5; 13:3; 15:22).

The impartation of miraculous gifts (Spirit) by the laying on of apostolic hands is the other (Acts 6:6; 8:14-19; 19:6; 2 Tim. 1:6). No other person was able to impart miraculous gifts by the laying on of their hands (cf. Rom. 1:11). Philip performed miraculous gifts in Samaria (Acts 8:5-7), but when the Samaritans were baptized, it was Peter and John who came laying their hands on them in order that the Samaritans could receive the Spirit and perform miraculous works (Acts 8:18-19). Therefore, Philip had the capacity to perform miraculous signs, but his ability was granted by apostolic ordination and could not serve to impart these works to others (Acts 6:5-6). All other instances of miraculous gifts performed might be best understood as having been granted by apostolic sanction (cf. Matt. 16:19; 18:18; John 20:23).

One passage that is a point of contention is when Ananias laid hands on Saul (Acts 9:17). Peter equated the reception of the Spirit as that of happening after repentance and baptism (Acts 2:38). The measure of the Spirit to which Peter spoke had no relation to the baptism with the Spirit but to the promise given to all who obey the Gospel (Acts 2:39; 5:32). Immediately after Ananias placed his hands on Saul, he regained his sight and was baptized, but there is no mention of the Holy Spirit's activity as in all other records of such ordination. Some contend that we cannot know the relationship of the Holy Spirit to Saul, but Ananias did not impart the Holy Spirit to Saul. Jesus' purpose for Ananias' laying on of hands was for Saul to regain his sight (Acts 9:12; cf. 22:13-16; Gal. 1:11-12, 16-18; 2:2). The statement of Ananias in verse seventeen may be taken one of two ways: 1) Ananias intended to convey that he would return Saul's sight, and then Saul would be able to receive the Holy Spirit (cf. Acts 2:4), or 2) Ananias intended for Saul to regain his eyesight and receive the Holy Spirit at the same time. Based on the construction of Saul's testimony in Acts 22:13-16 and Jesus' intended purpose for Ananias' hands in Acts 9:12, the former seems more plausible.

This church has had three distinct periods in our history. (1) Water Street Years 1909-1950, (2) Poplar Street Years 1950-1989, and (3) Glendale years 1989-present. It was during the early to mid 1950s that we adopted a more professional approach to things and two of those early preachers - William Medearis and Don Kester, were responsible.

William Medearis (1913-2003) served the church from December 1952-December 1955 and he organized the first church office. Don Kester (1914-1978) served the church from December '55 to December '57. The earliest bulletins that have survived are from late 1957 while Kester was still here but it is unknown when the very first bulletin was printed. The 1958 bulletin file is spotty but from that time onward, we have a very complete run of them and, **YES**, these carefully protected bulletins are frequently consulted for various bits of information.
