## Jesus Heads to Jerusalem (Luke 17–18:14)

As Jesus begins his final journey to Jerusalem, he encounters ten who suffer from skin issues. Jesus's route isn't the straightest path to Jerusalem, but it is in an area where Jewish and Gentile populations are present. According to the law, they stand at a distance to request healing, and he orders them to show themselves to the priests (Lev. 13:19; 14:1–11). Lepers were prohibited from temple grounds and all communal worship because they were considered unclean. Their obedience to Jesus' command results in healing as they go, but only one returns to Jesus to thank him and give glory to God. Luke makes a point to disclose that the one who returned was a Samaritan, "And *he* [*autos* is emphatic] was a Samaritan." We don't know whether or not the others were Jewish. Had they been, it would have been poignant that their illness caused them to cross this racial line to form a community with non-Jews. In Jesus' words, this man was a "foreigner" (*allogenes*). This one who could never have worshipped in the temple worships Jesus with gratitude.

The following section seems cryptic. Is Jesus talking about his second coming or something else? Some have suggested that it refers to the destruction of Jerusalem because similar language is used, as in Matthew 24. Yet, Matthew and Mark contain the flight of the people as a part of their accounts, but Luke doesn't mention fleeing at all. Plus, Jesus uses a couple of judgment stories to illustrate his point. I believe this is about the second coming because of a couple of expressions: "one of the days of the Son of Man" (v. 22). This is also referred to as "his day" (v. 24). The same is observed in Jesus' second coming passages (1 Cor. 1:8; 2 Peter 3:10). In this context, it's the day he will be revealed (v. 30). The disciples, however, would see difficult times, but on the heels of those times would be the vindication of the coming of Jesus.

Two parables follow this revelation. The first is a widow who seeks justice from a judge who seems wholly unfit for the job. Judges in Israel are supposed to defend widows against injustice (Exod. 22:22–24; Deut. 24:17–18). In those times, a widow could be a younger woman. Sometimes, older men married more youthful women, especially if their first wife died, so we needn't think of a gray-headed grandmother because that wasn't always the case. It can be, but it wasn't always. Because younger women might be widows, they were vulnerable to sexual mistreatment and poverty. These were notable when she lacked a son or close male relative who might support her. If a widow wears out an uncaring judge and gives her justice, how much more will we receive from a God who loves us?


