Did Tongues Continue?

I believe the miraculous gifts of the Holy Spirit ended sometime in the second century or thereabouts. The argument can be made from Scripture, such as the laying on of hands I wrote about last week. Also, there's an observation to make from history. That observation is that tongues aren't mentioned or attested to en masse beyond the second century until centuries later.

An assumption must be concluded: if tongues were to withstand time, evidence of the practice would also be witnessed in subsequent periods. Hearsay to the second-century writer, Irenaeus was the news that some spoke "all kinds of languages" (*Against Heresies* 5.6.1). This usage indicated the nature of tongues as an intelligible language. Quoting Irenaeus' passage, Eusebius added, "This will suffice to show that diversity of gifts continued among fit persons till the time I am speaking of" (*Church History* 5.7.6). This passage indicates that these gifts had ceased by Eusebius' time. Although Irenaeus does not speak of a firsthand account of tongues, he attributed to one named Marcus an unintelligible sense of the gift of tongues (*Against Heresies* 1.13.3).

The leading proponents of tongues and prophecies in the post-apostolic age were Montanists. Notable among this sect was the third-century African apologist, Tertullian. He advocated the exercise of the miraculous gifts in his region. Still, at the time, he and other Montanists were regarded as heretics by those who were orthodox. Tertullian's only mention of tongues was in a passing reference to the Apostle Paul's teaching. Early church historian Everett Ferguson contends that the Montanist controversy gave a sufficient opportunity for a topical reflection of the matter by others; however, no writer proposed to address this problem based on the assumption that all understood the practice to have since ceased.

An Egyptian Christian named Pachomius allegedly spoke in Greek and Latin while not knowing those languages, but historians cast doubt on this account. They believe it was invented to give that community credibility in the Christian world. Augustine writes about tongues as if they no longer existed as well. There are scant references to tongues throughout the centuries, but nothing as widespread as what we read in the New Testament.
